Education survey begins on Oct 23

The Government is going to conduct National Education Survey on post primary level education soon. The survey will begin on October 23 and continue till November 6.

The inaugural ceremony of the training programme of national trainer and master trainer, who will conduct the survey, was held at the meeting room of Bangladesh Bureau of Educational Information and Statistics (BANBEIS) on Wednesday.

Education Secretary Kazi Rakibuddin Ahmed attended the function as the chief guest while Director of BANBEIS Muhammad Shafiul Alam, Chief of Planning, Education Ministry Gopal Chandra Sen, Mohammad Elias Ali addressed it. Chairman of Dhaka Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board Prof. ATM Sharifullah was present at the function.

The Government has decided to conduct National Education Survey (post-primary) '99 with an objective to collect detail information and statistics about post-primary level education in the country so that it could help providing quality education to the students.

Addressing the inaugural ceremony Education Secretary Kazi Rakibuddin Ahmed urged the surveyors and the supervisors to conduct the survey sincerely. He said that all involved in the survey should be sincere because future planning and management of education would be taken on the basis of the reports.

The BANBEIS, an organ of the Ministry of Education will conduct the National Survey with the financial help of the United Nations Development

Programme (UNDP).

A total of 2400 surveyors and 480 supervisors from Government schools, Government colleges and vocational institutions have been appointed to conduct the survey.
