

HSC exam from May 2

A total of 95,479 candidates will appear at the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations of 1978 under the the four boards of intermediate and secondary education which will begin all over the country on May 2.

Of them 33,576 candidates will appear under Dacca Board; 23,017 candidates under Rajshahi Board; 20,675 candidates under Comilla Board and 18,211 candidates will appear under Jessore Board.

Group-wise break-up of examinees: science 43,384; Humanities-36,151; Commerce-13,447; Agriculture-1,864 Home Economics-193; Islamic Studies 19 and Music-16.

This year; there are 262 HSC examination centres under all the four boards including two overseas centres one in Kualalampur; Malaysia
