

300 educational institutions to be surveyed

About 300 educational institutions and concerned offices under the Ministry of Education will be surveyed under a sample survey programme to identify the condition of management of these institutions and offices, said an official handout, reports BSS.

The survey which has already begun includes 90 primary schools, 20 government secondary schools, 40 private secondary schools, 10 government colleges, 20 private colleges, 2 teachers training colleges, 12 primary teachers training institutes, 30 madrasahs, 4 polytechnic institutes, 15 zila education offices and 15 zila primary education offices. Besides, the teachers of ibtedai madrasahs and masjid-based maktabas will be brought under this survey.

One hundred and thirty senior government college teachers, zila education officers and upazila education officers will work for the sample survey.

Addressing a meeting of the concerned officials in Dhaka on Monday Education Secretary Kazi Azhar Ali said that successful completion of the sample survey will be helpful in making future programmes.
