Classes, exams not held at CU

chittagong, Aug 7: Classes and scheduled examinations were not held at the Chittagong University today, the first day of two-day class boycott programme called by Anti-Communal Student. Forum (ACSF) to press home its three-point demand including resumption of bus service for the students.

During the programme, the activists of ACSF locked the

maingate of the university and prevented all vehicles from entering the campus.

ACSF will continue class boycott programme today. It has also threatened to go for an indefinite strike at the university from August 10 if three-point demands are not met by August 9.

The students of the university has been agitating on the campus since Aug 1 as the authorities decided to stop bus service for the students in view of huge financial loss.

Meanwhile, Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) called a day-long strike on the campus on August 9 on the same demand. Shibir gheraoed the Vice-Chancellor's office and submitted a memorandum to CU syndicate demanding resumption of bus service.
