Siege programme at CU today

CHITTAGONG, Aug 4: Anti-Communal Students Forum (ACSF) called a day-long siege programme on the Chittagong University (CU) campus tomorrow to press home its threepoint demand including resumption of bus service for the students.

ACSF gheraoed the Vice-Chancellor's office today and submitted a memorandum to VC demanding immediate resumption of bus service.

The Forum held a rally in front of the VC's office and urged the general students to boycott classes tomorrow to make the siege programme a success.

Presided over by Shahjahan Chowdhury, president of BCL, CU unit, Ahsan Kabir Bengal, president of BCU and Nuruchhafa Zulhash addressed the rally.

lslami Chhatra Shibir will lay a siege to the VC's office to-morrow on the same demand. Shibir announced the action programme at a rally held on the campus today.

Earlier, the university authorities had stopped bus service for the students due to financial crisis.

A total of 22 buses were engaged for student transport service. The authorities took the decision in view of 'huge losses'.
