DU authorities firm to maintain peace in campus

Prof. Abdul Mannan, Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University said on Tuesday that the university authorities were determined to identify and take action against those who tried to disturb Sunday's peaceful rally and silent procession in the campus.

Addressing a meeting of the Education Environment Council of the University at the council room Prof. Mannan said that a peaceful academic atmosphere had been prevailing in the campus since the re-opening of the university on September 27.

The meeting recommended formation of an inquiry committee to find out and punish "those terrorists" who tried to

vitate the academic atmosphere.

The meeting in a resolution condemned the activities of the youth who tried to foil the discipline in the silent procession held on September 27. The meeting expressed its determination to maintain congenial academic atmosphere in the campus and to oppose all sorts of terrorism. Among others Prof. K. A. M. Saad Uddin, Prof. Ahsanul Haq, Prof. M. Akhtaruzzaman and a number of student leaders took part in the discussion.

The Education Environment Council called upon the students of various organisations not to raise slogans in and around the examination centres. The council also called for taking severe action against persons who would create obstacle to the construction works of the university.
