the university sine die. The vice chancellor, however, kept the syndicate decision in abeyance and said the university would be closed sine die if the situation further deteriorated.

Since then through a couple of days of uneasy. calm the situation slightly improved. The university authorities are, however, still worried about any sudden outbreak of violence and though at one stage the authorities were interested about the DUCSU polls they now seem to have lost interest in holding the elections apprehending fresh violence on the campus.

The Dhaka University also allegations that at one stage resolved to close is going without an elected DUCSU since 1983.

A Dhaka University teacher holding a responsible position said that the university authorities have no plans to announce any date for the DUCSU election soon. In fact, the possibility of holding the DUCSU election this year seems to be remote, he added.
