

## DU lost 215 days in '86

Classes in Dhaka University were held only 150 days out of 365 in 1986. A total of 215 days were lost as weekly holidays, scheduled vacations and strike by both students and teachers.

During the year, the number of scheduled vacations was 62 days while the weekly holidays were 104. Teachers observed strike for 55 days and the students for 20 days.

The teachers also observed 'two' and 'one' hour strike for 22 days besides, 51-day
