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DU reopens Sept 27

Dhaka University will reopen on September 27 after a forced closure of 73 days. Residential halls will open on September 22.

Dhaka University went on an unscheduled closure on July 15, following a violent clash between the supporters of pro-JSD (Inu) and BNP students organisation. Two students and one rickshawpuller were killed in that clash.

Dhaka University Syndicate fixed the date of reopening of the University in an adjourned meeting on Wednesday evening. The meeting was presided over by Vice-Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan.

News of the reopening of the University was confirmed by a Syndicate member.

The Vice-Chancellor was not

available for his comments.

Meanwhile highest academic bodies of the Dhaka University held a meeting on Wednesday morning with Vice-Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan in the chair.

The meeting fixed some examination dates. Third Year Honours final Examinations of 1981-82 session under course system of Science and Biological science will commence on October 15. The meeting said that Honours final examinations of 1982-83 session will start from December 15. First year final examinations of 1985-86 session will begin from November 10 and subsidiary examinations of the same year will start from November 25.
