Stray incidents of violence. took place in Dhaka University campus on Saturday, Traditional examinations were held but course tests were postponed.

The traditional examinations were however, held on schedule, the Controller of Examinations of the University told the Times. Most of the scheduled classes were not held on the day and attendance in the
