## DU authorities' statement motivated: BNP

Bangladesh Nationalist
Party (BNP) has rebuffed the
statement of Dhaka University
authorities which appeared in
Tuesday's newspaper and said
the statement was motivated and
biased.

Strongly protesting the contents of the statement, a BNP press release yesterday said that the DU authorities issued it with the motive of shifting [the / responsibility of their mismanagement and favouritism / and hooliganism on the campus onto the shoulder of BNP and its leader Bogum Khaleda Zia and thereby tarnishing the image of the party and its leader.

The BNP said the responsibility of maintaining law and order on the campus rested with the university authorities and the government. Because of a number of reasons, the 1 present Vice-Chancellor of DU had become a controversial figure a and his position has become vulnerable, it said adding to cover up his failure, inefficiency and malpractices he had called upon the BNP leader to interfere in the campus affair.
