### No classes held at DU as JCD calls strike

Classes were not held and all the offices remained closed yesterday at the Dhaka University as Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) called a strike protesting the killing of Bazlur Rahman Shaheed, a leader of the organisation.

Earlier on Monday the university authorities postponed all the examinations scheduled to be held from December 13 to 15 at the University centres.

Shaheed who was expelled from the University in September last year for his alleged involvement in campus violence was shot dead at Mohsin Hall on Sunday night.

wore black badges and hoisted black flags atop different hall buildings. At about noon, a rally was held in front of the Arts building in this connection. It was addressed by JCD president Asaduzzaman Ripon.

He said government-backed elements were responsible for the killing of Shaheed and demanded exemplary punishment of the killers.

Later, a silent procession was brought out.

Meanwhile, two gatekeepers of Mohsin Hall were taken into police custody yesterday morning for interrogating them about the killing of Shaheed. They were picked up by police also on Monday and released later. This time they were not freed till last night.
