panels known as blue white and pink.

Until the last election it was a fight between two panels blue and pink. But the pink panel was bifurcated this year allowing blue to secure 22 seats. White had eleven and pink a miserable two seats. Dr. Aminul Islam of Soil Science, polled 416 votes, which was the highest. He was followed by Muniruzzaman Mian of Geography who polled 366 votes. Dr. Yeazuddin Ahmed of Soil Science and Sirajul Islam Chowdhury of English were tied to the third place with 365 votes.

The total number of voters were 815 of whom 741 cast their votes.
