

### Anti-VC panels win DU dean elections

Elections to the posts of dean of six faculties of the Dhaka University was held yesterday.

A total of 16 candidates contested in the elections from three separate panels—white, pink and blue. The candidates from white and blue panels (known as anti-Vice-chancellor) won three posts each while no candidate from the Vice-Chancellor supported pink panel was elected. The panel did not nominate any candidate for the posts of dean of the faculties of Science and Law.

Those elected as deans for a two-year term (1989-90 and 1990-91) are: Arts Faculty Dr. Wakil Ahmed of Bengali Department (white number of votes-67) Social-Science Faculty Dr. Anwarullah Choudhury of Sociology Department (white, votes-41), commerce Faculty Dr. Khandaker Bazlul Haq of Management Department (blue, votes: 27), Science Faculty—Dr. M. Aminul Islam of Geography Department (Blue, votes-89), Biological Sciences Faculty—Dr. Yeazuddin Ahmed of Soil Science Department (white, 77) and Law Faculty—Dr. Jahurul Islam Choudhury of Law Department (Blue, 6).

Held at the Teacher-Student Centre of the University the election was conducted by Dr. Abdullah Farook, Treasurer of the University.
