

Blasts at FH Hall of DU

Police yesterday searched five rooms of Fazlul Haq Hall of Dhaka University after several crackers were allegedly hurled from the top floor of the hall building. None was, however, injured in the explosions.

Police and witnesses said, the crackers were thrown from the top floor of the building when some students from the nearby Shahidullah Hall, reportedly belonging to Abhi-Group of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), were passing by the F H hall at about 1.30 pm. Abhis rivals belonging to Ilias Group of JCD are said to be living in F H Hall.

Police rushed to the spot following a request by the hall authorities. Police along with the hall authorities broke open five rooms of F. H Hall and searched those but failed to recover anything witnesses said.

The searched rooms include the room of F.H Hall students Union Vice-President Habibul Islam Habib, said to be a supporter of Ilias. Police looked for Habib during the search but he was not found.

Police was posted in the hall premises

ned the incident and demanded arrest of the persons responsible. Both the statements alleged that those who shot and wounded Ziaur Rahman Hall Students Union V. P. Mamatajul Haq Rafiq earlier, attacked the students of F. H. Hall and blasted several 'bombs' yesterday.

The leaders of the two hall unions further alleged that one Asfak, whom they described as a relative of a police inspector of Babupura outpost, was involved in the incident.
