Call to resist move to foil DU Senate session

Thirtyfive members of the Senate of Dhaka University elected from the teachers' quota, at a meeting on Wednesday alleged that certain quarters were conspiring to foil the first session of the fifth Senate of the university scheduled to be held on June 28.

Held at the Dhaka University Club Building with Prof. Masihuzzaman, a senate member and President of DU Teachers Association in the chair, the meeting demanded holding of the Senate session as scheduled and called upon all concerned to resist any conspiracy in this regard.

The meeting observed that the Senate session was very important as the budget of the university is approved by it. It also stressed the need for electing the Senate members from the registered graduates' quota without any delay.

The last Senate session ended in a row over the system of election of the registered graduates to the Senate.
