

DU graduates' representatives polls put off

The Dhaka University Syndicate at emergency meeting on Thursday last unanimously decided to postpone the election of registered graduate representatives to the Senate and last date of submitting nomination paper on June 7 and April 23, respectively.

The meeting also formed a six member committee headed by Barrister Shafiq Ahmed in order to examine whether there was any legal deficiency in preparation of the registered graduates' voters list according to the Syndicate resolution of April 15 and objection by registered graduates regarding validity of voters list.

The meeting was convened by Vice-Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan on the basis of the allegations made by DU Teachers Association (DUTA) and teachers' representatives to other bodies including Senate and Syndicate.
