

DU Senate election postponed

The syndicate of the Dhaka University at an emergency meeting yesterday, postponed the election to the Senate of representatives from the registered graduates quota scheduled to be held on June 7.

Chaired by Vice-Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan the meeting also formed a six-member committee headed by Barrister Shafiq Ahmed to examine whether there was any legal defect in preparing the voters list of the registered graduates.
