Dhaka University authorities at an emergency meeting on Wednesday reviewed the latest situation of DU campus with the Vice-Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan in the chair.

The meeting was attended among others by the Pro-Vice-Chancellor Prof Emajuddin Ahmed, treasurer Prof Abdullah Farook, teachers representatives to the syndicate, the faculty deans, departmental heads, hall provosts, house tutors, directors of the institutes, proctors, official heads, DUCSU representatives and presidents and secretaries of all associations including Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA).

dul Mannan urged the members of law enforcing agencies to arrest the expelled students and the persons involved in terrorist activities to free the campus from violence.

The provosts of different halls opposed the idea of reopening the university before ensuring security of the teachers, students and officials. They favoured police raid in residential halls and expulsion of unwanted and outsiders from the campus.

Pro Vice-Chancellor Prof Emajuddin Ahmed underscored the need for a joint discussion between DUCSU and hall students union representatives to improve the overall situation in the campus.

The DUCSU Vice-President and General Secretary vowed to maintain congenial academic atmosphere on the campus after resumption of classes from February 17.

Secretary, Ministry of Home, IG of Police and Metropolitan Police Commissioner with the Education Minister in the chair to discuss various issues regarding resumption of classes from February 18 by controlling the deteriorating law and order situation of the campus. Syndicate member and Additional Secretary, Education Ministry, Mr Nuruddin Al Masud has been requested to arrange the meeting.

Presided over by the Vice-Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan the meeting reviewed the latest situation of the campus and held that a few expelled students of 1987 were frequently roaming about the campus. They even threatened the hall provosts with dire consequences including attempts on their lives, the meeting observed. The Syndicate urged members of the law enforcing agencies to take necessary steps against the persons.

The Syndicate members held that the news conference arranged by Mohsin Hall provost was against the rules of the university. The syndicate called upon all sections to refrain from such activities and help the inquiry committee to get accurate information about the February 9 post election violence.
