

Gun shots rock DU campus

Dhaka University campus was again rocked by gun shots when a group of persons freely used firearms in front of 'Madhur Canteen' around noon on Thursday. None was, however, hurt in the incident.

Witnesses said the incident was a part of internecine quarrel between the two factions of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal.

Habibul Islam Habib and Habib-un-Nabi, Vice-President and General Secretary respectively of F.H. Hall Students Union in a statement alleged that the armed persons shot at Khairul Kabir Khokan and Gautam Mitra, former Convener and General Secretary respectively of the Dhaka University unit of Chhatra Dal. The attackers allegedly created terror at Fazlul Huq Hall and Shahidullah Hall areas while moving in motorcycle brandishing fire arms.

Nine student organisations condemning the Thursday's campus incident accused the stooges and agents of the Government of creating terror on the campus and disunity among the student forces on the eve of the observance of Shaheed Hossain Day (November 10). The nine student organisations blamed outsiders for the campus violence on Thursday.

The students organisations urged the students to unitedly resist what it called autocracy and intensify movement for elimination of communalism and terrorism on the campus.

The students organisation brought out a procession on the campus in protest against terrorism unleashed by armed persons.

Leaders of Samajtantrik Chhatra Front accused the Government for creating terror on the campus on Thursday. They called for forging unity of the students to foil any conspiracy by the Government.
