Injunction on DU Senate session

The Dhaka University authorities have postponed the first annual session of the fifth Senate of the university scheduled to begin today as an ad-interim injunction has been issued restraining holding of the session.

The injunction was issued by the fourth court of assistant judge, Dhaka following a prayer filed jointly by AKM Shahidullah and AKM Ali Reza, both registered graduates of the university.

Mr A Z. Shikder, Registrar and Secretary of the Senate, yesterday issued letters to all Senate members informing them of the injunction on holding of the session.

The first session of the fourth Senate also could not take place following an ad-interim injunction on holding of the session by the same court.

There is no representation of the registered graduates in the present Senate as an election to this effect was not held.
