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The Institute publishes two journals of international standard.

The Centres of Advanced Study and Research in Science and Biological Science. Faculties generally manage and support project research programmes in various department and these Centres have achieved considerable success in establishing the image of Dhaka University in the field of research activities. These are six such Centres dealing with research programme in Science.

1. Bose Centre for Advanced Study and Research (Faculty of Science)
2. Centre for Advanced Study and Research in Biological Science (Faculty of Biological Sciences)
3. Renewable Energy Research Centre.
4. Computer Centre.
5. Centre for Biotechnology.
6. Centre for Urban Research (Department of Geography).

These Centres generally support approved advanced research conducted by teachers of various department of Science and Biological Sciences mostly dealing with projects for the application of knowledge of science

and have achieved quite significant success in providing services, solutions of problems of developmental activities and advancement of knowledge.

Conclusion

The development of research activities in Dhaka University has now been directed toward multidisciplinary and inter-disciplinary approach in view of the need of time and in the national interest. This is one aspect of the urgent calls that developmental activities is making in the university education and research.

Dhaka University is destined to play a pioneering role in the endeavour toward synthesizing research activities in the existing natural, human and social sciences by new SPECIALISM corresponding to our real life in the days to come. In making this options the University of Dhaka must put its own house in order so that the system of specialized, diversified and significant talents are in constant use in building of a just, peaceful and progressive society in Bangladesh.
