



New DUCSU office-bearers take over

The newly-elected office-bearers of the Dhaka University Central Student Union (DUCSU) on Sunday took over their charges from the Vice-Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan who is also the President of the DUCSU at a simple ceremony, a University official said, reports BSS.

They were elected in the DUCSU election held on February 8 as candidates of the Central Student Action Committee (CSAC), an alliance of 13 student organisations.

The CSAC put up a united panel which won the elections defeating the candidates of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal and bagging all the 20 seats in the DUCSU.
