Bombs found at DU hall

## Students asked to behave with provosts, poll officials

Tension again gripped the Dhaka University campus as bombs and lethal weapons were recovered from a residential hall yesterday morning.

The Syndicate of the university at an emergency meeting yesterday reviewed the latest situation on the campus and warned that stern action would be taken against those who were reported to misbehave with the provosts, house tutors and officials related to DUCSU and Hall unions elections.

Police recovered 30 handbombs and some lethal weapons kept in a gunny bag under the water tank on the roof of Ziaur Rahman Hall. No arrest was made immediately in this
