## Bombs found at DU hall

# Students asked to behave with provosts, poll officials

Tension again gripped the Dhaka University campus as bombs and lethal weapons were recovered from a residential hall yesterday morning.

The Syndicate of the university at an emergency meeting yesterday reviewed the latest situation on the campus and warned that stern action would be taken against those who were reported to misbehave with the provosts, house tutors and officials related to DUCSU and Hall unions elections.

Police recovered 30 hand-bombs and some lethal weapons kept in a gunny bag under the water tank on the roof of Ziaur Rahman Hall. No arrest was made immediately in this connection.

Dr Abdul Mannan, Proctor, Dr Khodadad Khan, Provost of the hall, and DU Teachers Association leaders were present during the raid.

Immediately after the raid the hall units of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dai brought out a procession in protest against police entry into the hall. The processionists were chanting slogans against the Vice-Chancellor and the proctor of the university.

Presided over by Vice-Chancellor Prof Abdul Mannan the syndicate meeting observed that a section of students at

different halls were misbehaving with the provosts and house tutors and returning officers of the elections on different pleas. The meeting said such misbehaviour was punishable according to the university rules and added that stern action would be taken against the students concerned.

The vice-chancellor informed the meeting of the recovery of bombs and lethal weapons from Ziaur Rahman Hall and said that the campus situation was under control.
