

Varsity Ordinance '73 to be updated

President Ershad said in Dhaka yesterday that various steps taken for the restoration of proper and healthy academic atmosphere in the educational arena had already started yielding positive results, reports BSS.

Speaking at the regular monthly meeting of the Vice Chancellors of the universities at the International Conference Centre, the President expressed

the confidence that with the help of all concerned we shall be able to regain our past glory.

At the outset of the meeting the Education Minister Sheikh Shahidul Islam gave an overall picture of the situation prevailing in the campuses and said confidence among the general students had been restored as a result of the measures taken by the government.
