Traditional masters in DU

There has been a long standing provision for traditional Honours Graduates from colleges to complete their Masters Final Year from Dhaka University in all the concerned departments. But very unfortunately the Economics and Political Science Departments of D.U. have been refusing admission to College Honours graduates of Master Final year from the current session which is, of course, a serious example of injustice and discrimination in the same university. In Chittagong and Rajshahi Universities also, there are provisions for college Honours graduates to complete their Masters Final Year from the concerned departments. In some colleges like Eden Girls' College, Rajendra College, B. M College, etc., Masters Courses have

been introduced without providing minimum facilities as regards properly qualified and required number of teachers, library, space, etc. and under these circumstances it is not at all wise to offer and study Masters courses in these colleges if the students want to develop proper academic background which is, of course, their human and social rights. We believe our Government and Dhaka University authorities are certainly trying to ensure better education to our children. Still, in fine, we request the DU authority to admit Honours graduates from all colleges in Masters Final year in all the concerned Departments (including Economics and Political Science).
