Three students and a street urchin were killed in the incident.

The dates of Honours and Masters Degree final examinations were shifted eleven times due to volatile campus situation.

The examinees, narrating their agonies in the memorandum, said academic sessions of the university have been lagging behind by more than three years and they are no more ready to increase the backlog.

The examinees urged the Vice-Chancellor to arrange holding of the examinations either outside the campus or at the university taking all possible security measures.

The Vice-Chancellor assured them that he would take a decision in this regard after discussion with all concerned.
