

DU Syndicate to take disciplinary actions

Dhaka University Syndicate in an emergency meeting yesterday (Monday) decided to take disciplinary actions against those responsible for Sunday's incident.

The meeting, held with the Vice-Chancellor Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Miah in the chair, reviewed the incidents of Sunday and expressed its concern over it.

It may be mentioned here that some members of Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) following arrest of four of their leaders, went on rampage and attack the residences of the Zahurul Huq Hall Provost, the Vice-Chancellor, and the University Club. They fired gunshots at random creating panic among the campus dwellers.

The syndicate meeting urged the students, teachers and employees of the university and members of law-enforcing agencies and all section of the people to help maintain peace on the campus and remove terrorism once for all.

hold a discussion meeting comprising Syndicate members, teachers association, deans, provosts, proctors, and teachers representatives in the Senate on the ways and means to make campus free from violence.

The meeting condemned the incidents of harassment of the Zahurul Huq Hall Provost, cutting the telephone line of his residence, ransacking his house, firing towards the Vice-Chancellor's house and attacking the University Club Bhaban.
