**DU students term**

Students of the Departments of Chemistry, Applied Chemistry, Bio-Chemistry and Micro-Biology of Dhaka University on Monday in a memorandum handed over to Dhaka University Vice Chancellor Prof A.K. Azad Chowdhury demanded removal of the existing disparities in the appointment of qualified persons in production, quality control and research work at country's Pharmaceutical industries through amending clause No. 13 (1) of the Drug Ordinance of 1982.

Later the students in a procession went to the Directors Drug Control and staged a demonstration there to lodge their protest against the existing disparities.

The students also termed the Drug Ordinance of 1982 as undemocratic and unscientific and completely contrary to drug policy of the World Health Organisation (WHO) and not recognised by any country of the world.
