DU teachers castigate \ Emajuddin

Forty five teachers of Dhaka
University DU on Sunday protected the statement of former
Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof. Emajuddin
Ahmed made recently in which
he said the present government
is removing persons of different
opinions from important posts
since its taking over.
