

## Non-student loses membership Senate forms Trust Fund for DU development

Shaheed Uddin Chowdhury Any, a Dhaka University Senate member as the DUCSU representative, on Monday lost his membership as the hall and administrative authorities confirmed that he is no more a student of the university, reports BSS.

Ismat Kadirk Gama, a registered graduate representative to the Senate in its Sunday's session raised a question on the membership of Any and said he has no moral and legal authority to be nominated as the DUCSU representative as he is not a student of the university at present.

Despite Any's claim on Sunday that he is a student of the Institute of Education and Research of the University, authorities on the Monday confirmed the details about his studentship.

Vice-Chancellor and Senate Chairman Prof AK Azad Chowdhury on Monday asked Mr. Any not to participate in Monday's proceedings of the senate. However, Any was not present in the session on Monday.

The Senate on Monday formed a Dhaka University Development Trust Fund to explore the ways and means to

enhance the income of the university for the implementation development projects.

The senate formed the 18 member fund committee with advocate Abdus Salam Talukder as its convener. The other members of the fund are Kaji Akram Uddin Ahmed, Shah Zalat Majumdar, Prof. M. Akhtaruzzaman, Advocate Syed Ahmed, Advocate Ozaer Faruq, advocate Syed Rezaur Rahman, Dr. Harun-or-Rashid, journalist Azizul Islam Bhuiyan, Prof. Ali Ashraf MP, K.M. Zahangir MP, Habibur Rahman Khan, Mahfuza Khanam, Prof. Abdul Mannan, Prof. Shahadat Ali and Prof. Saaduddin. The Vice-Chancellor, pro-Vice-Chancellor and the treasurer of the University will also be the ex-officio member of the fund.

Speaking on the development issues Senate member Azizul Islam Bhuiyan volunteered to donate 10 per cent of his monthly salary to this trust and made a call to former students of the university scattered all over the world, to extend financial and moral supports to this fund.
