## VCs condemn attack on Azad

Vice-Chancellors of universities on Thursday condemned Tuesday's attack on Dhaka University VC Prof AK Azad Chowdhury by unruly students during evacuation of dormitories for rehabilitating bonafide residents, reports UNB.

In a statement, members of the Bangladesh University Parishad Standing Committee of Vice-Chancellor also expressed deep concern, saying the countrymen were shocked at the attack.

They said the incident proved that a handful of terrorists in a planned way wanted to disrupt peace and stability of the university.

The VCs demanded exemplary punishment of the persons responsible for the attack and also stressed that law-enforcing agencies should keep surveillance to prevent recurrence of such incident.

statement on Thursday also strongly protested and condemned Tuesday's campus incidents.

They said that there was no language to condemn the heinous incident. The JCD workers had mandandled the Vice-Chancellor and teachers. which was unprecedented in the history of Dhaka University. The Naked action of JCD on the campus at a moment when the authority was sincerely trying to establish academic atmosphere on the campus is a well planned and calculated move to create chaos and confusion at the directives and instigation of their political masters.

They also bitterly criticised and condemned the remarks of some BNP leaders who in a press meet had attempted to justify such barbaric act as "demonstration of anger" of their golden boys.
