Barisal Medical College closed sine die

BARISAL, May 29:—Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College was today closed sine die to avert eruption of violence on the tense campus, says UNB.

The decision was taken in an emergency meeting of the Academic Council as the campus situation deteriorated over the last few days due to rivalry between the student wings of ruling BNP and Opposition Awami League.

The meeting, presided over by Principal Prof Abdul Karim, also asked all residents to vacate their respective halls by 2 pm this (Monday) afternoon.

The authorities, however, decided that all the scheduled examinations would be held in time and asked students to stay nearby to appear at their exams.

Violence, clashes, chase and counterchase between the supporters of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal and Chhatra League had been continuing on the campus and in halls over admission of new students.
