### **Tk 55 cr for Dhaka Medical College uplift**

Taka 55 crore will be spent for the development of Dhaka Medical College during the current fiscal year, reports BSS.

Meanwhile, work is now under progress for reconstruction of the old building of the Medical College Hospital and construction of houses for the employees.

A total 432 quarters will be built in nine six-storied buildings for Class Three and Class Four employees of the college at a cost of Taka 12 crore. The construction of these quarters will be completed by December next year.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Chowdhury Kamal Ibne Yusuf on Monday laid the foundation of the new buildings for Class Three and Class Four employees of the college at Elephant Road.

Speaking on the occasion the Health Minister said each department of the hospital had been built as self-sufficient unit.
