

Theft of certificates Arrested four placed on remand

The Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court yesterday placed on a one-day police remand four persons arrested for alleged involvement in the stealing of 26 master's certificates of the Dhaka University, Ramna police said.

The office of the Controller of Examinations of the university had filed a case with Ramna thana in this regard.

Two of the arrested — Kazi Khairul Basher and Billal Hosain — are employees at the

Controller's office. The others are Shaheed, a medical attendant at Surya Sen Hall and Salek, a tea stall owner.

Of the stolen certificates, 18 are M.Sc, five M Com and three M A.

Earlier, a four-member probe committee was formed by the university authorities to investigate the incident and asked to submit its report within 15 days.

When asked, an official at the Controller's office said that "partially prepared certificates which were kept for delivery the following day, might have been stolen."

The Vice Chancellor and the Controller of Examinations of the university were not available for comments till the filing of this report at 10 last night.
