DU authorities open library despite ongoing officers' strike

The Dhaka University authorities made special arrangement yesterday to open the central library to the students despite the on-going strike by the members of the Inter-University Officers' Federation.

DU Proctor Dr Nur-un-Nabi and teacher Dr. Rafiqullah Khan opened the library at around noon.

The move was taken in the face of the inconvenience of the students, especially the course final examinees, caused by the 15-day strike.

A large number of students of the university threatened to launch their own action programme if the library was not opened yesterday.

The administrative activities, however, remained suspended for the second day in a row due to the strike.

Meanwhile, operations of the university transports were partially affected yesterday due to fuel shortage as the transport manager was abstaining from work. Bus service was available on only four of the 13 routes on the day.

Classes were held as usual while the residential halls and department offices remained open.

The federation called the strike on Sunday to press home their 4-point demand.
