

DU officers continue strike

All administrative activities of the Dhaka University have come to a virtual halt as the officers of the university continued, their strike for the third consecutive day yesterday.

Officers of all universities of the country began a week-long strike from March 2 to realise their four-point demand.

The demands include provision for representation of officers in the Senate and Syndicate, revision of their pay-scale, extension of retirement age to 65 years from 60 years and stopping the 20 per cent cut from the pension of the officers.
