

# Female students at DU demolish two hall gates, ransack provost's office

A section of residents of Shamsunnahar Hall of Dhaka University, demolished two gates inside the hall and ransacked the provost's office late Wednesday night, witnesses said.

Residents of the hall got angry as a new gate was built on Wednesday on the way to canteen from the hall annex building.

They started a signature campaign against this in the evening and demolished the gate at around 10:30 pm.

The students also broke another gate built for checking their identity cards when they enter the hall.

After midnight, they also ransacked the provost's office inside the hall and chanted slogans against the hall authorities.

Proctor of the university, Nur-Un-Nabi rushed to the spot at around 12:30 am. He asserted that he would soon arrange a meeting of the residents with the Vice Chancellor to discuss various problems of the hall.

A number of residents of the hall

hall, talking to The Daily Star, alleged that they were being harassed in the name of checking identity cards. "Every time we enter the hall, we are to show the identity cards. This is illogical," one of them said.

They alleged the monthly coordination meeting of the provost, house tutors and the residents were not being held for a long time leaving many of the problems unresolved.
