The seriously injured student was dent of Chittagong College Unit of Chhatra League. The student leader, a fourth year medical student of the. college was hit with bullets on his

Following this incident of violence, it a prolonged enmity between the supporters of Chhatra League and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) over . the reign of student politics in the CMC.

About 200 Chhatra League supporters raising party slogans were identified as Abul Hasnat Moham-in parading the CMC campus at around mad Rezaul Hasan Reza (24), Presi- , 12 noon. With the sudden outbreak of shoot out and explosion of bombs panicstricken students ran helter-skelter. Some sustained injuries at the stamped and some were also hurt with bullets and bomb splinters. The student leader Rezabeing profusely injured was the lone person left behind. The police later rescued him.

Except, Keza, none of the injured students took admission into the Chittagong Medical College Hospital. As a result, the identity of other injured students could not be known.

The tense situation is still prevailing in the Chittagong Medical College. The police have been deployed to maintain law and order there. The Panchlaish Police arrested one outsider Helal from the college hostel.
