JCD-BCL clash

DMC closed sine die

Dhaka Medical College (DMC) was closed for indefinite period on Wednesday following a clash between two rival groups, late Tuesday night.

The clash took place between Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and Bangladesh

Chhatra League (BCL) (S-P) activists in which at least four students were injured.

Among the injured two JCD activists Palash and Sohel were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) with bullet injuries.

Resident students said that during the clash at least 20 rounds of gun shots were traded between the two groups at Fazlay Rabbi Hall at 4 a.m. which created panic among the resident students, teachers and employees of the college. At that time two JCD activists were shot at.

ACADEMIC COUNCIL

Academic Council of DMC in an emergency meeting on Wednesday noon decided to close the College for indefinite period to avoid further untoward incident with college principal Ahsanuzzaman in the chair.

Meanwhile in separate statements to the press on Wednesday BCL (S-P) and JCD leaders blamed each other for the incident.
