Madrasha teachers demand payment of salary

THAKURGAON, May 13.—A meeting of Madrasha teachers of 400 Ebtedai Madrasahs of five thanas of Thakurgaon district was held recently at Thakurgaon. The meeting was presided over by Mr. Rafiqul Islam, President, Thakurgaon Press Club.

The speakers said that the previous governments promised to give salaries of 14,000 Ebtedai Madrasha teachers of the country but till now the Government has not implemented the decision.

Besides this, the Government is not supplying books for the Madrasha students for which the teachings of Madrasha students are being hampered seriously. The speakers demanded to pay salaries of the teachers immediately and to supply books for the students.
