DU Masters examinees postpone strike

A section of masters final year examinees of the Dhaka University yesterday withdrew their two-day student strike from Saturday following a meeting with the Vice Chancellor in the afternoon.

The students under the banner of 'Sadharan Chhatra-Chhatri Brindo' (general students) yesterday had announced plans to enforce the strike on the campus demanding rescheduling of their examinations.

The announcement came from a rally, held in front of the VCs office where the students laid siege at noon.

However, the students postponed their programme till Monday as the VC assured them of a solution within the time.

Earlier, the students brought out a procession on the campus and held a rally at the Aperajeo Bangla, to press home their demand.

Addressing the rally, the student representatives demanded rescheduling of their examination by at least one month so that they can prepare properly.

The masters' final year examination is scheduled to begin from early next month.
