

BCL men go on rampage at Mohakhali

5 JL men injured in Feni factional clash

ACTIVISTS of Bangladesh Chhatra League, the ruling Awami League-backed student organisation, rampaged through Titumir College area at Mohakhali and vandalised several vehicles as AL-backed labour organisation Sramik League men allegedly beat assaulted one of their fellows on Monday.

About Chhatra League men vandalised several buses and cars from 2:30pm to 3:30pm causing panic in the area, said Banani police sub-inspector Jahangir Alam.

The incident halted traffic on the busy Mohakhali-Gulshan road for more than an hour, he said.

The police contained the situation firing bullets at about 3:30pm, he said.

The Chhatra League activists took to street after one of their fellows was assaulted by the local Sramik League men, witnesses and police said.

Carrying sharp weapons, both the groups took positions at the both ends of the road in front of Titumir College at about 2:15pm, witnesses said.

Titumir College unit Chhatra League president

Kazi Mirazul Islam Dollar said that a Chhatra League activist of Titumir College unit was beaten by Sramik League activists, patronised by Dhaka City Sramik League president Delowar Hossain, in the morning, prompting the protests.

New Age Feni correspondent reported that at least five activists Juba League, the AL-backed youth organisation, were injured in a factional clash at Fulgazi on Sunday night. Fulgazi police officer-in-charge Harun-ur-Rashid said that a case was filed in this connection.
