



## CU BCL calls strike protesting ICS attack

CHITTAGONG, Nov 3:— Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) of Chittagong University (CU) Unit called for an indefinite strike on the campus from tomorrow (Sunday) in protest against what they called 'indecent attack' by Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS).

A total of 25 activists of BCL activists including Jillur Rahman Jewel and Nasir Haidar Babul the President and General Secretary of CU BCL respectively were injured today when they tried to enter in the campus.

According to our campus sources and eye witness, when some 35 activists of BCL arrived at the Railway Station of the university by a bus at 11.30 am leading by its President Jillur they came under attack of ICS activists. After seeing BCL men

at Railway Station Square of CU the ICS activists rushed to them. The ICS-men used brick stones, blunt instruments and strikes to beat BCL activists. CU BCL President was beaten up brutally. At one stage he fell on the road. Police rescued him from there and sent him to the Gate No-1 of the university which is well-known as BCL area.

After a short while, Nasir Haidar Babul, GS of CU BCL tried to enter in the campus. With some of his associates he fell in front of ICS procession at Ratha Pahar area. The ICS man chased them and beat them. Babul along with his party men took shelter under police protection at University Railway Station. Later police passed them Gate No-1
