mitories.

It was settled at a tri-partite meeting of the university authorities, leaders of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) at the administrative building on Sunday noon.

As per decisions of the meeting, the ousted BCL activists will be reinstated at Zahurul Huq Hall on Tuesday and Jagannath Hall on Wednesday.

Vice Chancellor Prof Anwarullah Chowdhury, Pro-VC Prof Zinnatun Nesa Tahmida and Proctor Prof Nazrul Islam attended the meeting from the authorities side. DU unit president of JCD Monir Hossain led the JCD delegation while acting President of DU unit of BCL Beg Shahin Jahan led the BCL team.

BNP's student front JCD and student wing of Awami League BCL will sit again on Tuesday with the final list of students for rehabilitation, leaders of both the organisations said.

The BCL activists were ousted on November 13 following a clash between the two rival student bodies.

After the meeting Monir Hossain said JCD was always in favour of peaceful coexistence and will ensure it at any cost.

General Secretary of BCL DU unit AKM Azim said his party would watch the authorities' sincerity to restore the academic atmosphere in the university.
