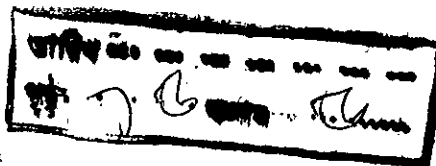

BCL against opening of CU

CHITTAGONG, Aug 28:- Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) leaders expressed their determination to enforce indefinite strike on the campus from the opening day if the university authority opens it without

without fulfilling their 6-point demand.

The leaders of BCL, student wing of Awami League, in a meeting with the CU authority again called for restoration of congenial atmosphere on the campus. Their demands included punishment to those Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) members who are responsible for the attacks on the BCL activists, removal of the Provost of Shahid Abdur Rab Hall and recovery of illegal arms from Gate No. 2 which is well known as ICS stronghold.

Held at the Vice-Chancellor's room at 12 p.m. today the BCL leaders said that the authority of CU must not open the university without meeting their demands.

The authority of CU closed the university sine die on August 13 following a bloody clash between ICS and BCL which left more than 20 students injured.

Meanwhile, the Syndicate of CU will meet August 30 to discuss about the reopening of the university classes.
