



KU officers, employees begin indefinite strike

KHULNA, Aug 13:—Khulna University is facing an impasse due to strike called by Teachers, Officers and Employees for an indefinite period.

No classes or examinations are taking place, offices are not running and KU authority is also reluctant about taking any step for solving the problems.

Vice-Chancellor Professor Dr. S.M. Nazrul Islam whose tenure ends on August 22 next has already left Khulna bag and baggage.

KU Teachers Welfare Association started non-stop strike on August 8 last protesting at VC's passive role during KU Treasurer Sarder Abdur Razzak murder incident and following developments that also accused association's President Rezaul Karim of the murder.

KU Officers Association and Employees Union started since the strike from today in support of their demands. They demanded immediate start of appointment of officers and employees that was postponed in the face of teachers' movement.
