The SSC examinees of the up-

oming examinations alleged that ne school authorities had realised xtra money beyond the Board's rescribed rate.

Tk 20 and examination centre fee is Tk 100, boy scout or girls guide fee Taka 10 and education week fee is Taka 5. Thus the total amount of examination fees stand at Taka 590 and Taka 555 for Science and Humanities and Commerce Group respectively.

The Comilla High School authority realised Taka 1600 as examination fees including other dues for Science Group and Taka 1550 for Humanities and Commerce Groups each. Begum Jamila High School and Naria High School of Nangolkot Upazila Taka 1645 for Science Group and Taka 1600 for Humanities group respectively. Extra manities group respectively. Extra fees has been realised in other schools of Nangolkot upazila.

The school authorities in the rural areas of the district have realised SSC examination fees including other fees like school fees.

The guardians of SSC examinees are compelled to sell the immovable property to pay examination fees. Due to financial crisis at least 20 per cent student will not be able to pay fees any they can not sit for the examination.

There is no provision that th school authorities will show th marks of the individuals obtained at the test examinations in th form to be sent to the Education Board. Some guardians of the SSC examinees posed question how the school authorities sent the filled up forms to the Board' office who failed in the test examinations showing imaginary pass marks in the forms. pass marks in the forms.

When contacted some Head masters admitted the fact of taking excessive fees for the coaching classes but they denied the unfai means of realising fees from the students who failed in the tes examinations.

There were many glaring in stances of cheating and other un fair means that were adopted it various centres during the SSC examinations last year.

A total of 1440 examinees were expelled for adoption of unfair means in the halls during the English and Bengali examinations last year. The number of expulsions was quite high and the numbers of disturbances and acts of violences in different centres during the examinations last year

increased.

Without appropriate changes in educational policy, administration, manpower management and in all other relevant fields, the existing chaotic condition in educational sector would further worsen and coming the conscious people of Comilla maintained.
