## 3400 SSC examinee expelled on Tuesday

Some 3400 students were expelled in the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations across the country on Tuesday for adopting unfair means in the examinations. Mathematics examination was held on the day.

Twenty-one teachers were also expelled from different examination centres of Rajshahi, Chittagong and Barisal boards for assisting examinees in copying.

Of the total expelled examinees 1625 were expelled from Rajshahi board, 393 from Dhaka board, 495 from Comilla board, 288 from Chittagong board, 324 from Jessore board, 237 from Barisal board, 46 from Sylhet board.

The highest 15 teachers were expelled from Rajshahi board, while five teachers from Chittagong board. One teacher faced expulsion from Barisal board.
